Merged A Teams

Last year the CDLA had adopted a revised tiering document beginning last year. The number of teams competing in each division A, B or C for Peewee, Bantam & Midget boys has changed based on club enrollment numbers.

Please be advised that every club now has an opportunity to compete in the A division, either by hosting their own A teams or via a designated merged club. Rockyview is merged with the Strathmore Venom for the A divisions. CDLA wide releases in the boys tiered divisions and specifically for the A division will NOT be required. For 2017 the merged A teams will be wearing a neutral jersey and hold practices and home games in a neutral location which is still to be determined.

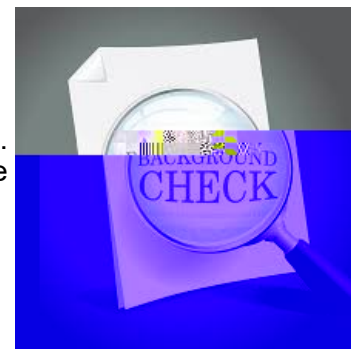

Police Checks

The CDLA now requires that all coaches, managers and trainers complete a “vulnerable sector” Police Information Check. This will include a full search of Canada-wide Criminal Record History, Vulnerable Sector Search and Police history. Local police information and Alberta Provincial Court records will be included.
